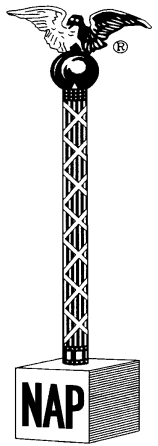

After consideration of recommendations from the Board of Directors, Officers and members, the Bylaws Committee proposes the following Bylaw amendments:

**ARTICLE XI – DELEGATES TO NAP CONVENTION  
SECTION 1 – NAP DELEGATES:**

**Amend by striking out the entire section and inserting a new section:** “The number of delegates to the NAP Convention shall be as prescribed by the NAP Bylaws”
